


Acknowledgment of Country



From the rush of four-wheel-driving or mountain biking, the tranquillity of fishing or hiking, there are endless natural wonders to explore.

If you're a mountain person, you'll fall in love with Mount Arapiles, traditionally known as Dyuritte. Mount Arapiles is a spectacular feature, rising sharply from the Wimmera plains to form part of the Mount Arapiles, Tooan State Park. Mount Arapiles is rich in Aboriginal history and home to hundreds of native flora and fauna species, rock art, and native animals including wallabies, kangaroos and birds of prey.

If the water is calling, you've chosen the right place to visit. The Wimmera River is the largest river in the state of Victoria that doesn't flow into the ocean; instead flowing into a series of lakes including Lake Hindmarsh and Lake Albacutya. There are walking trails, swimming spots, and plenty of other ways to enjoy the river, including boating and fishing.

GET OUTDOORS

You could spend a lifetime exploring the majestic mountains, lakes, waterfalls, rivers and wetlands surrounding Horsham and still never scrape the surface of what Mother Nature has to offer. But with so many choices, the best time to start is now. After all, you can never have too many adventures.





MUST DO ACTIVITIES

FISHING

Standing on the shore line of Taylors Lake, cast your line and take in the soothing sound of the water lapping at the lake's edge. It doesn't take long before you reel in your first catch of the day, Redfin and Yellowbelly are popular in the area.

But Taylors Lake is just the beginning of your fishing experience in the Wimmera region. In the wetter years, Green Lake, Natimuk Lake, Rocklands and the Wimmera River are all great options and worth a visit.



HIKING

Perhaps the jewel in the region's crown when it comes to hiking is the Grampians Peaks Trail, a 160km multi-day backpacking route that winds its way across the Grampians from Mt. Zero in the north to Dunkeld in the south.

The trail rises and falls sharply, and with each step, visitors can take in ever-changing terrain; sandstone formations, boulder-strewn pathways, lush fern-filled forests, and 360-degree views that rival long-distance trails anywhere in the world.

Nights are spent under canvas in purpose-built, hike-in campsites with basic facilities (fees applicable) or in ecofriendly hiker huts (accessible only with a Licensed Tour Operator). Completing the entire trail is no easy feat, but waking up here will be a memory etched into your consciousness for a lifetime.

If hiking the entire trail isn't for you, then one, two or three-night adventures are the perfect way to experience the magnificence of the trail. For day hike options, you could try the steep ascent to Mt. Zero or try a shorter walk such as Zumsteins to MacKenzie Falls.



CAMPING

Whether you prefer the unspoiled nature of a National Park campsite, or the convenience of a caravan park with on-site facilities, you'll never be short of camping options.

Most National Park campsites in the region include basic amenities such as pit toilets, fireplaces and picnic tables. Be sure to arrive before sunset and watch the mob of friendly kangaroos feeding on the lush grass as the sun sets around you. To camp in the National Park sites you need to book through Parks Victoria.

There are also endless caravan parks available to book along the river, lakes, and at the edge of the National Parks. Free and low-cost camping and caravanning options can also be found, which makes waking up to stunning sunrises, and falling asleep to star-studded skies, possible for everyone.

BOATING

Lovers of water activities will be right at home, with water skiing, canoeing, boat fishing, sailing and more, available all year round. There are plenty of places to go boating on the river, as well as many of the lakes in the region.

Green Lake is the most popular lake and you'll often see locals enjoying a swim in the crisp waters, windsurfing when the conditions are right, water skiing, and fishing. With toilet facilities and a picnic area, it's the perfect place to spend the day.

Taylors Lake is a great option for boating activities. Rocklands Reservoir is renowned as the best Redfin fishing in Victoria with trout also in good supply. While many lakes are suitable for boating all year round, some, like Natimuk Lake, can run dry during summer or when there's been little rain.

4WD

From beginner-friendly trails to gnarly roads that will ensure even the hardiest four-wheel-driver is impressed, the region's 4WD tracks will keep you busy for days.

The Grampians National Park self-drive route takes in some of the area's most famous sights including Zumsteins, MacKenzie Falls, Lake Wartook, Reeds and Boroka lookouts, Lake Bellfield, Roses Gap, and Mt. Zero.

The Grampians Black Range self-drive is located in the Black Range State Park adjacent to the Grampians and is home to significant Aboriginal cultural sites. It offers a unique landscape of gentle slopes, in direct contrast to the rocky outcrops of the neighbouring Grampians National Park.

To the west of Horsham you will find the Little Desert National Park, known for its self-drive 4WD routes (high clearance 4WD only). Located between Horsham and Dimboola, Little Desert, as its name suggests, has very soft, deep sand and it's therefore recommended to lower tyre pressure to 20 psi or less and to always travel with a minimum of two vehicles.

The Horsham and Grampians Visitor Information Centre has free detailed self drive touring maps available.

MOUNTAIN BIKING/CYCLING

Nothing can beat the feeling of exploring by bike. Enjoy the warm breeze on your face as you peddle along the winding cycle tracks and immerse yourself deep into the landscape.

If you choose only one trail to explore, make it the Arapiles Big Sky Bike Trail, a 33km journey to the world-famous Mt. Arapiles, a unique rock formation rising 140 metres above the Wimmera plains and home to ancient Aboriginal culture and world-class rock climbing.


Or, if you're looking for something shorter, try the Mackenzie River/Bun-nah Trail. This route is just 10.5km and meanders between Wartook Valley and Zumsteins Picnic Area, immersing riders in history with every peddle.

WATERFALLS

If you love nothing more than the roar of a waterfall, you're in the right place. The Grampians is home to Victoria's largest waterfall, MacKenzie Falls.

It flows all year round and is accessible via an easy-to-get-to viewing platform, which is also accessible to prams and wheelchairs. Or, you can descend (and ascend) the steep 260 steps to the lower falls and feel the might of MacKenzie in all its glory.

Beehive Falls is another stunning waterfall, accessed by a 2.4km undulating walk and is best visited after seasonal rain.



ARAPILES BIG SKY BIKE TRAIL

The Arapiles Big Sky Bike Trail connects the small town of Natimuk to Mt Arapiles, which rises dramatically from the Wimmera plains. The trail is a 33km off-road recreational trail looping through the verdant landscape surrounding Natimuk, Natimuk Lake, Mitre Lake, Mitre Rock and Mt Arapiles.

As you make your way along the trail you will discover grasslands that host up to 500 plant species, you can climb sand dunes and, in Spring, behold magnificent canola fields stretching to the horizon. You may also encounter some of the local wildlife. From the pinnacle of Mt Arapiles you will enjoy magnificent views of the surrounding areas stretching from the Little Desert National Park in the north to the Grampians in the east.

The Arapiles Big Sky trail can be completed as a loop, be experienced in smaller sections and is best travelled with a mountain bike.



BINGO

FISHING

Enjoy diverse, year-round recreational fishing across the region from freshwater rivers, lakes and reservoirs which provide good catches from the shore or boat. The most commonly caught species include trout, redfin, murray cod and golden perch.

POPULAR FISHING LOCATIONS

GREEN LAKE

Located on the Western Highway and the gateway to Horsham, this sandy shore reserve has boat ramps, picnic and barbecue facilities and is popular with Horsham residents for all general water-based recreation.

ROCKLANDS RESERVOIR

A well-known spot for a variety of water activities, the reservoir boasts a wide range of fish species as well as bank fishing near the dam wall.



LAKE TOOLONDO

A favourite spot for fly fishing, bait and lure fishing for brown and rainbow trout and redfin. A boat ramp and toilets are available at the northern end and camping is available on the eastern shore at a privately operated park.





LAKE WARTOOK

Located in the Grampians National Park, Lake Wartook is a beautiful clear lake, the oldest rural reservoir in Victoria and one of the largest lakes in the region. An anglers' haven for catching Brown Trout and Redfin, the lake offers boat fishing as well as bank fishing off the wall.

WIMMERA RIVER

Famous for having one of the largest and richest fishing competitions in Australia (held in March on Labour Day Weekend), the Wimmera River provides good fishing for a variety of fish. Popular fishing spots include the Weir and Riverside areas.

TAYLORS LAKE

Popular for boating, water skiing, and fishing, Taylors Lake is also a popular free camping spot located approximately 20km on Horsham-Lubeck Rd via the Western Highway. It was once known as the most popular murray cod fishing spot in Victoria. Fishing licenses can be obtained online at: service.vic.gov.au. Or ask the friendly team at the Horsham and Grampians Visitor Information Centre.



HORSHAM WALKING TRAILS

Walk, jog or ride one of Horsham's many trails along the Wimmera River, through the Botanic Gardens, around the Wotonga Basin, down to Weir Park and the Wetlands, the Yanga Track or Riverside. Take in some of the sites along the way including many of Horsham's public art pieces, the War Memorial and Cenotaph at Sawyer Park or the Anzac Walk Bridge.

If you're looking for somewhere to let your dog run free, you'll find an off leash dog park at Weir Park or near the road bridge on the eastern side of the river.






HORSHAM MILITARY COLLECTION

Horsham is excited to have recently added a new stop on the popular silo art trail. The Horsham silo and flourmill site celebrates the little-known but locally significant story of a Wotjobaluk warrior's story of leadership, resilience and significant legacy. The mural was created by Australian photo realism artist Smug.

Titled Yangga Dyata which means Walking on Country, Horsham's silo art celebrates the story of Wotjobaluk warrior, Yanggendyinanyuk. Yanggendyinanyuk (whose name means 'his walking feet' in Wergaia language) was born in 1834 in Wotjobaluk Country in the Wimmera Region of North-Western Victoria. His life was marked by outstanding achievement and leadership but was marred by significant loss and grief. Yanggendyinanyuk was celebrated for his role in finding the Cooper-Duff children in the 'Lost in the Bush' story and for his part in the first Indigenous cricket tour to England. Tied together with the adjacent flour mill image of Yanggendyinanyuk's totem the Black Cockatoo the images portray the strong linkage to country that the region has.

Horsham Rural City Council commissioned Juddy Roller street art company to engage world renowned street artist 'Smug' to transform Horsham's silo and flour mill as a tribute to Yanggendyinanyuk.

Smug said: "I was very excited to be asked to paint the silo and work with Aunty Jennifer and BGLC, HRCC and the Plazzer family. I am truly honoured to be chosen to celebrate Yanggendyinanyuk with such a large and prominent mural. I hadn't painted a full figure for many years so I welcomed the challenge of painting a composition outside of my comfort zone. My hometown is as close to Horsham as you can get in size and similarities, and its name Nowra even translates to "Black Cockatoo", so I felt incredibly at home throughout the installation of the mural."

Traditional Owner Aunty Jennifer Beer, Cultural Consultant for the project said: "This painting has only just scratched the surface of the history of Yanggendyinanyuk and his life. The mural has blown me away! It's a legacy my children will get to know, and my grandchildren, as well as our community generations. For myself, I only got to know about him when I was in Grade 3 and I was reading a reader to my grandfather and he told me the story of




my ancestors. There are many community families that are tied to the Lost in the Bush and First 11 cricketers, this mural will help the stories to be told."

The Yangga Dyata artwork is a collaboration between Horsham Rural City Council, Barengi Gadgin Land Council, owners of the silo Mario and Frances Plazzer and Juddy Roller.
