YANGGA DYATA -WALKING ON COUNTRY

The Horsham silo and flourmill site celebrates the little-known but locally significant story of a Wotjobaluk warrior's story of leadership, resilience and significant legacy. The mural was created by Australian photo realism artist Smug.

Titled Yangga Dyata which means Walking on Country, Horsham's silo art celebrates the story of Wotjobaluk warrior, Yanggendyinanyuk. Yanggendyinanyuk (whose name means 'his walking feet' in Wergaia language) was born in 1834 in Wotjobaluk Country in the Wimmera Region of North-Western Victoria. His life was marked by outstanding achievement and leadership but was marred by significant loss and grief. Yanggendyinanyuk was celebrated for his role in finding the Cooper-Duff children in the 'Lost in the Bush' story and for his part in the first Indigenous cricket tour to England. Tied together with the adjacent flour mill image of Yanggendyinanyuk's totem the Black Cockatoo the images portray the strong linkage to country that the region has.

Horsham Rural City Council commissioned Juddy Roller street art company to engage world renowned street artist 'Smug' to transform Horsham's silo and flour mill as a tribute to Yanggendyinanyuk.

Smug said: "I was very excited to be asked to paint the silo and work with Aunty Jennifer and BGLC, HRCC and the Plazzer family. I am truly honoured to be chosen to celebrate Yanggendyinanyuk with such a large and prominent mural. I hadn't painted a full figure for many years so I welcomed the challenge of painting a composition outside of my comfort zone. My hometown is as close to Horsham as you can get in size and similarities, and its name Nowra even translates to "Black Cockatoo", so I felt incredibly at home throughout the installation of the mural."

Traditional Owner Aunty Jennifer Beer, Cultural Consultant for the project said: "This painting has only just scratched the surface of the history of Yanggendyinanyuk and his life. The mural has blown me away! It's a legacy my children will get to know, and my grandchildren, as well as our community generations. For myself, I only got to know about him when I was in Grade 3 and I was reading a reader to my grandfather and he told me the story of



my ancestors. There are many community families that are tied to the Lost in the Bush and First 11 cricketers, this mural will help the stories to be told."

The Yangga Dyata artwork is a collaboration between Horsham Rural City Council, Barengi Gadgin Land Council, owners of the silo Mario and Frances Plazzer, Creative Victoria and Juddy Roller.

Green Lake	Located on the Western Highway and the gateway to Horsham, this sandy shore reserve has boat ramps, picnic and barbecue facilities.	
Horsham Yacht Club	Green Lake, 8283 Western Highway, Bungalally	
Lake Toolondo	A favourite spot for fly fishing, bait and lure fishing for brown and rainbow trout and redfin. A boat ramp and toilets are available at the northern end and camping is available on the eastern shore at a privately operated park.	
Lake Wartook	Located in the Grampians National Park, Lake Wartook is a beautiful clear lake, the oldest rural reservoir in Victoria and one of the largest lakes in the region. An anglers' haven for catching Brown Trout and Redfin, the lake offers boat fishing as well as bank fishing off the wall.	
Rocklands Reservoir	A well-known spot for a variety of water activities, the reservoir boasts a wide range of fish species as well as bank fishing near the dam wall.	
Taylor's Lake	Popular for boating, water skiing, and fishing, Taylors Lake is also a popular free camping spot located approximately 20km on Horsham-Lubeck Rd via the Western Highway. It was once known as the most popular murray cod fishing spot in Victoria.	
Wimmera River	The Wimmera River provides good fishing for a variety of fish. Popular fishing spots include the Weir and Riverside areas.

Start Point: Horsham, VIC

Distance: Approx. 42.6 km west (30 mins) to Wartook Valley

8:00 am Depart Horsham for Wartook Valley. Enjoy a peaceful early morning drive through the Wimmera landscape.

8:45 am MacKenzie Falls

Option 1: Easy walk to the lookout platform **Option 2:** Steeper 2 km return walk to the base of the falls

One of Victoria's most iconic waterfalls, stunning year-round flow.

10:00 am Zumsteins Historic Area Just 7 minutes from MacKenzie Falls.

Explore the pioneer settlement ruins and take the 4.6 km return trail to Fish Falls
