LOCATION

Horsham Rural City is a vibrant, diverse community located approximately 300 kilometres north-west of Melbourne and just north of the Grampians National Park, in the heart of the Wimmera region of Victoria, Australia. The municipality has a population of around 20,000, with three-quarters of residents living in the urban area of Horsham.

Situated approximately halfway between Melbourne and Adelaide, Horsham is a key regional service centre.

DESTINATION HIGHLIGHTS

Within easy reach are the picturesque playgrounds of the Grampians, Mt Arapiles, and the Little Desert National Parks. These destinations offer excellent opportunities for adventure-based team-building activities, including abseiling, rock climbing, horse riding, orienteering, and water activities. For those seeking a softer adventure experience, options include bushwalking, fishing, wine tasting, olive plantation and manufacturing tours, cultural art walks, and more.

FACILITIES

Horsham boasts a range of unique and high-quality venues including the highly acclaimed Horsham Golf Club, Wimmera Events Centre, Sylvania Park Host Farm, and the Horsham Town Hall.

The city offers venues to suit any event size—from small groups to theatre-style seating for 500 at the Town Hall, and up to 1,000 seated guests at the Wimmera Events Centre.

ACCOMMODATION

Horsham and its surrounds offer over 1,000 beds, ranging from caravan parks to five-star luxury accommodation.
