

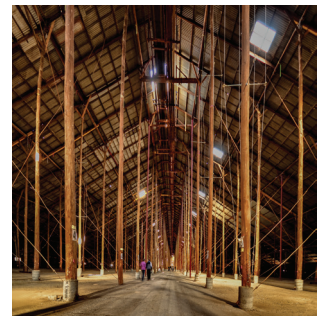
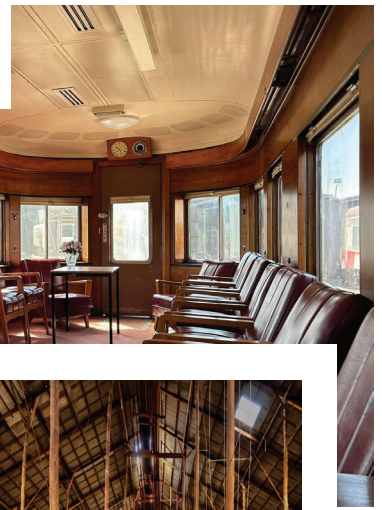

- Today you may wish to stay in Horsham for the day or join one of our options trips:
- Join a short shuttle to Murtoa to take in all the fun of the Murtoa Big Weekend activities, Murtoa Races, visit the spectacular Stick Shed, view the silo art or visit the local museums.
- Or enjoy one of our two optional day tours including a visit to the spectacular Grampians (Gariwerd) National Park (see next page for details).
- Or join us for a full day on the train to Beulah, viewing silo art at Sheep Hills and enjoying the long table lunch at Beulah.

DAY 3

Sunday 6 October 2024

- Today you may wish to stay in Horsham for the day or join one of our options trips:
- Or join our day out to the rarely travelled Rainbow Branch with two options:
 - Disembark at Jeparit to visit the local museum, explore and have lunch (BYO - not included)
 - Disembark at Rainbow and visit historic Yurunga Homestead and have lunch (Optional lunch available)
 - Both options allow for you to visit the silo art at Arkona

NOTE: Passengers wanting to return to Melbourne early may join the 'Overland' this afternoon from Dimboola at 1:30pm or Horsham at approx. 2pm (own expense). Seats may be available to be booked through V/Line for this service.

DAY 4

Monday 7 October 2024

Rejoin the train this morning at Horsham. Enjoy a light lunch as we retrace our journey back to North Shore, Melbourne or Seymour and the end of our Wimmera weekend adventure. - (L)

Additional Tours

Saturday 5 October 2024

Beulah & Silo Art - full day - \$200* adult | \$130* child

Join us aboard the train to explore the Hopetoun Branch. Full day passengers will view the magnificent silo art at Sheep Hills and disembark at Beulah and enjoy a sit down three course long table lunch featuring local produce[^].

Grampians & Halls Gap - full day - \$220* adult | \$120* child

Tour by private coach visiting Zumsteins historic site, Reed & Boroka Lookouts, Brambuk: The National Park & Cultural Centre, view Lake Bellfield and enjoy free time to explore Halls Gap. Includes a light lunch with tea & coffee.

(Passengers should be fit and able to walk 40 minutes and should wear suitable clothing and walking shoes.)

Grampians Wine Tour - full day - \$260* adult | \$110* child

Tour by private coach visiting Best's Wines including guided tour and wine tastings. Enjoy lunch at Pomonal Estate including a paddle of wine. Visit Fallen Giants Vineyard for tastings then continue to Kerries Kreation to taste local handmade chocolates. Finish the day with guided wine tasting at Staplyton Wines before returning to Horsham.

Jeparit & Silo Art - full day - \$100* adult | \$50* child (BYO lunch)

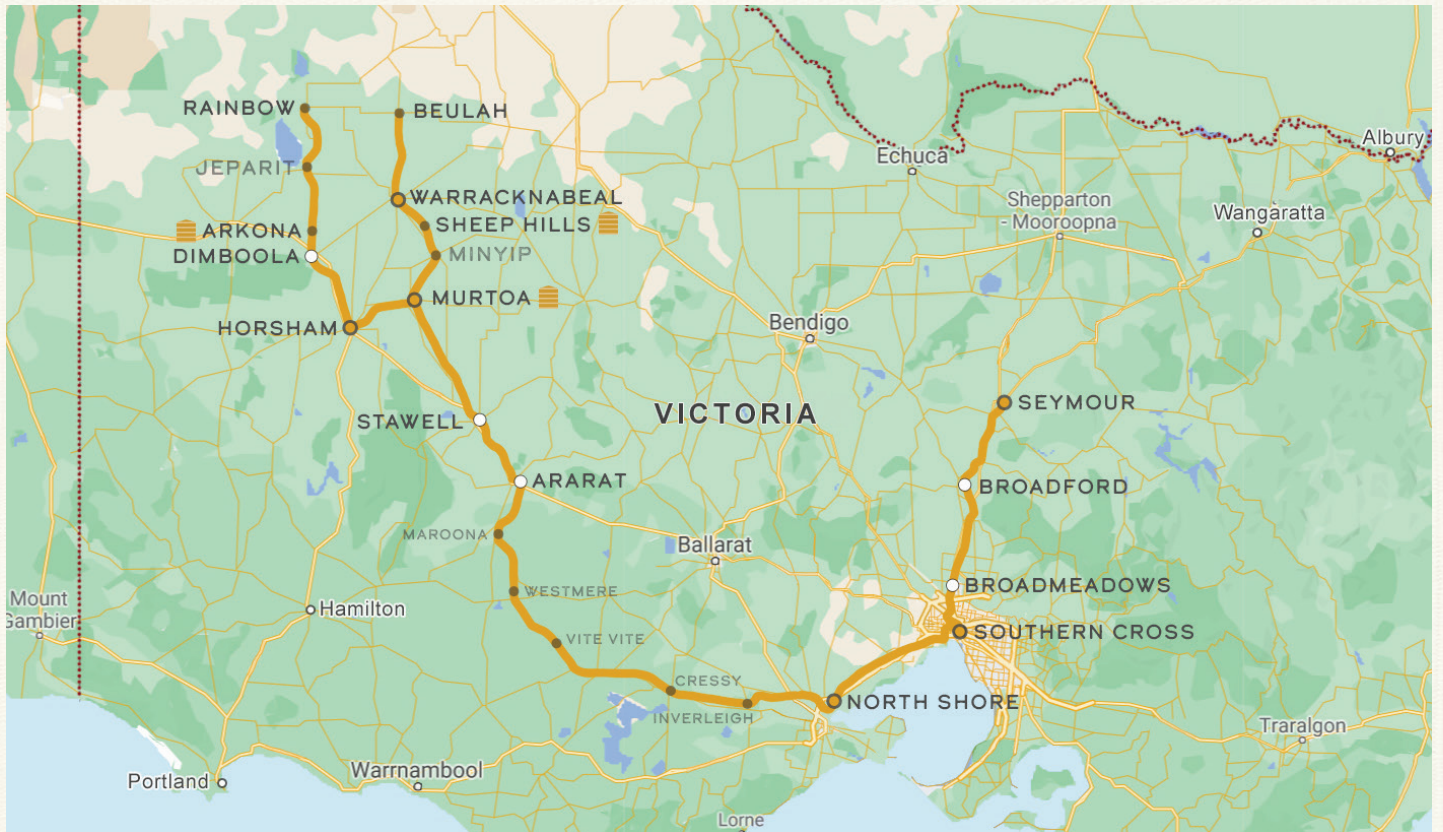
